2. Scottsdale Airport Part 150 Noise Compatibility Study - Scott Gray

- The third of five meetings will be held this Thursday night, August 12, 2004.
- These meetings are a proactive process by the City of Scottsdale to observe, map and certify the noise footprint of Scottsdale Airport traffic.
- This is the second time the City of Scottsdale has undertaken a noise compatibility study, all for the purpose of stating that the Scottsdale Airport is in compliance with FAA guidelines for airport noise standards.

New Business/Issues:

1. FAA TFR Airspace Restrictions - Brian Ready

- Anticipate a one day TFR September 27th for a political visit.
- Anticipate a three day TFR October 12th - 14th for the Presidential debate.
- These TFR restrictions are ten nautical miles centered on Sky Harbor Airport.

- Flight departments must check for the NOTAMS for specifics. These NOTAMS are typically issued 24 hours or less before activation.
- Deer Valley Airport may be the best alternative for aircraft operations during these restrictions.

2. Sky Harbor Airport Construction Plans - John Rudd

- Taxiway "R" overlay start sometime in September.
- Taxiway "D" reconstruct around October to December time frame.
- Close taxiway "S" for approximately one year to tear down and reconstruct. Should start immediately after Fiesta Bowl (January, 2005).

3. North Valley Radar - John Rudd & Scott Gray

- North valley SR-11 radar has an approved site (Union Hills & Central Ave.)
- The site is on state land and is in the final environmental study sign off stage.
- The FAA has budgeted money for 2006 construction and completion.
