Arizona Business Aviation Association Scholarship Application

The Arizona Business Aviation Association (AZBAA®) is an association that works to promote the business aviation interests and growth in the State of Arizona. AZBAA® will award a minimum of three scholarships with values of at least \$2500 each to applicants who are enrolled full-time at an Arizona college or university and interested in pursuing a career in business aviation. Scholarships will be awarded for Spring 2010 and checks will be made payable to the individual and the college or university.

Awards will be made to U.S. Citizens without regard to sex, race, religion or national origin.

Application Requirements:

- 1. Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen.**
- 2. At the time of application, a candidate must be officially enrolled for the academic year at an Arizona college or university. Proof of enrollment must be provided prior to distribution of this award.**
- 3. Applicant must be an undergraduate in an Arizona aviation-related two-year, four-year, or postgraduate degree program.**
- 4. Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or above, based on a 4.0 scale.**

The following must be returned with the completed and signed application:

- 1. An official transcript for the applicant from educational institution.**
- 2. Two 500 word, double-spaced, typed essays answering two questions. First, describe the current state of business aviation in America today. Secondly, what steps would you take to improve the industry and communicate its value to the country?**
- 3. Three letters of recommendation. One personal reference (not family), with emphasis on the candidate's strength of character, as well as two professional references from a teacher, employer, or supervisor.**
- 4. Applicant's resume.**
